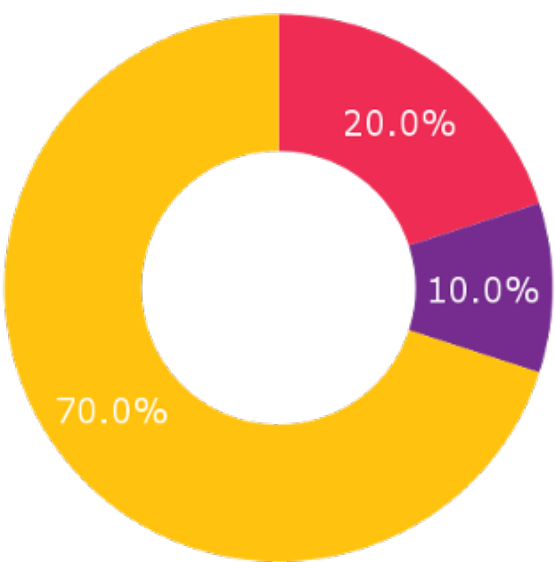

# Type of activity



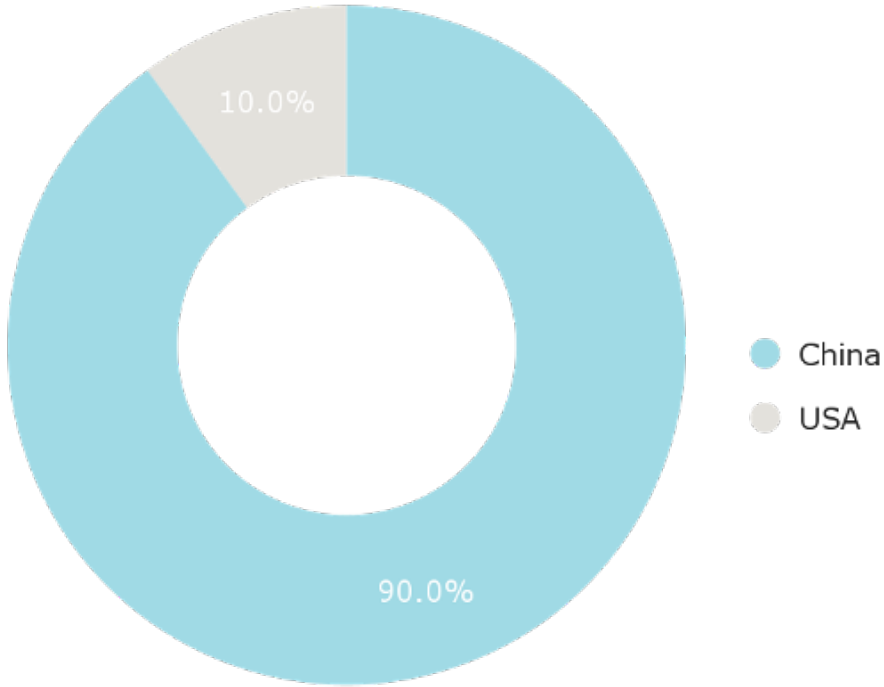
**Fundraising:** an event whose primary purpose is to raise money for a community partner

## Mother's English

Mothers English is a China focused English learning support program of DMECC, currently led by Myungha Kim, a DAIS sophomore. Founded in 2016 with the goal to provide adequate English language support to primary age, Mothers English helps Chinese village students residing in Dalian. Mothers English strives to teach these children English through a friendly, engaging, and collaborative method. Currently, there are around 50 youth volunteers and around 100 Chinese students that are receiving support from Mothers English.

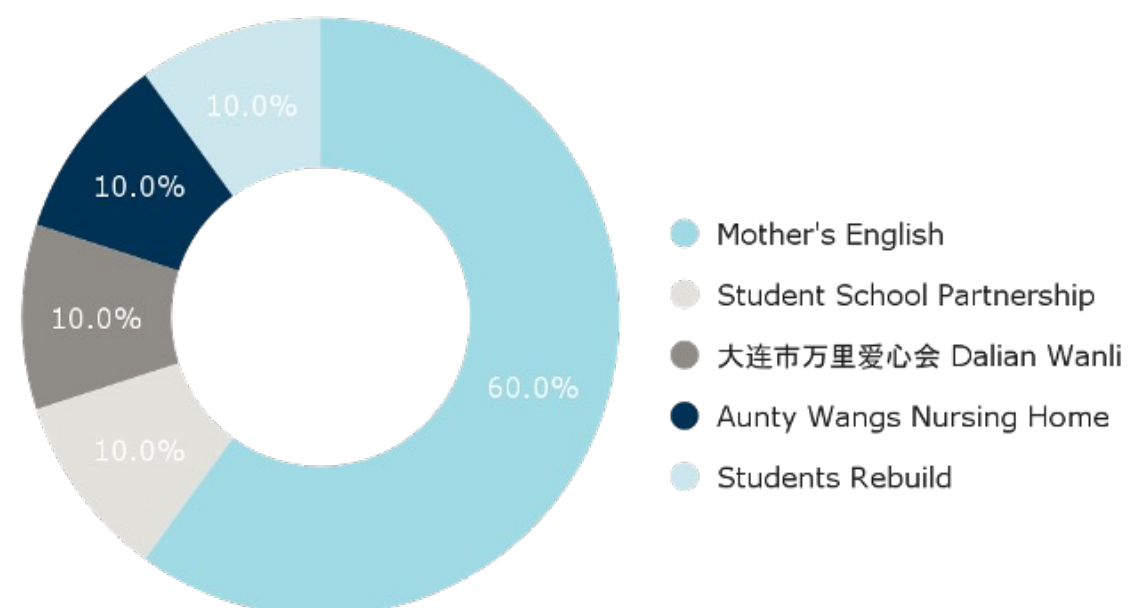
Wanli Charity Association of Dalian is a 5A charitable organization. In the past few years, the Charity Association has carried out various public welfare activities for more than 9,900 times, helped more than 200,000 people in need, participated in volunteer activities for more than 500,000 people, and provided social services for more than 1.98 million hours. It is a strong public welfare brigade active in Jinpu New District and even Dalian. Among them, the Spring Rain volunteer service program has helped more than 6,000 students in need, distributed more than one million RMB funds, and indirectly benefited more than 20,000 people, achieving the good effect of 'help a person, help a family'. Its non-governmental mediation programs have resolved more than 2,000 cases of various social conflicts, benefiting more than 85,000 people.

This is a local nursing home that serves the needs of elderly people who have medical or social issues. Some of the residents were previously homeless or facing difficult circumstances

# Welcoming Refugees Project

November 2022

Students Rebuild is an organization that helps to educate children about global issues, and gives them an opportunity to help through making art. This year, Students Rebuild is teaming up with humanitarian aid organizations around the globe to inspire change through the Welcoming Refugees Project. Together, we're teaching students about refugee crises, how to make our communities more welcoming and open, and how small actions can make a big difference. Kids will channel their creativity to welcome people displaced by war and other crises by creating postcards. The Bezos Family Foundation is donating \$5 USD to refugee-aid organizations for every postcard created, so students will see the difference they're making first-hand. Through this initiative the Pre-K to Grade 5 students at DAIS Elementary were able to raise \$655 through their works of art



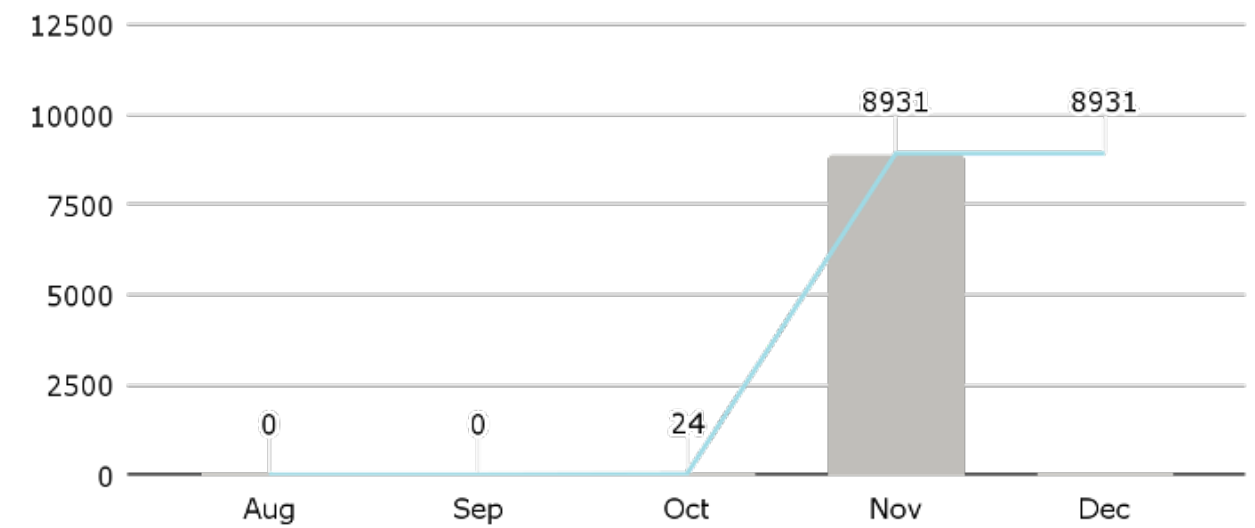

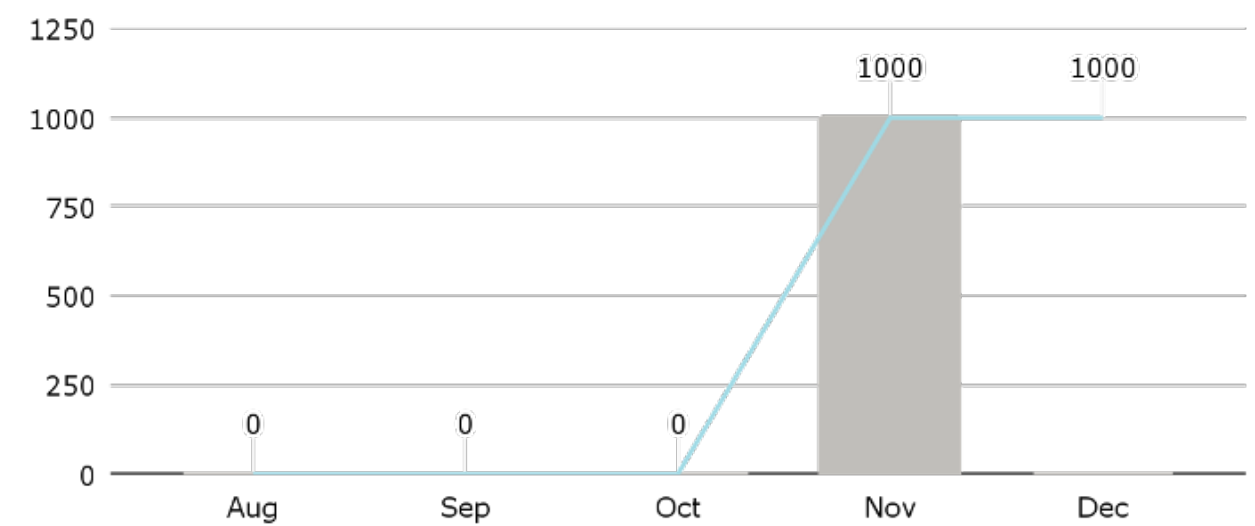
